Things to look forward to this term:

In English we are starting a new text, 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. Using this text, children will be writing letters, creating character portfolios, drawing inferences from characters' thoughts and feelings and identifying key points from the plot.

In creative lessons this term, we will be creating our own computer game packaging. Children will be exploring different examples of these, and will use these inspirations to help create their own.

In computing sessions, we will be creating our own computer games to go with the packaging designs.

RE this term focuses on the Gospels. Children will be introduced to many different bible stories, and will compare their ideas with the ways in which Christians interpret biblical texts.
