In maths, we will be further developing our knowledge of fractions, applying this to reasoning and problem-solving activities. We will also be deepening our understanding of decimals and percentages.

Our topic header for this term is 'Flourishing'. In creative lessons, the children will be exploring and developing their understanding of the Egyptians. Throughout this topic, the children will be exploring the culture, lifestyle and traditions of the Egyptian people.


In RE this term, we will be 'digging deeper' into the salvation aspects of the Bible, investigating different biblical stories and figures, and making links between these and our contemporary lives.
