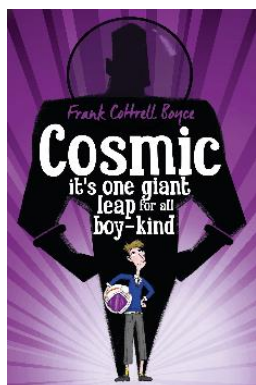


Year 5 - Newsletter

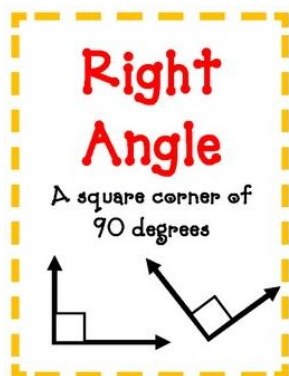
Welcome to Term 6. We have many exciting things to look forward in this last term as we lead up to the summer break.



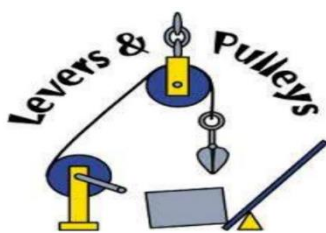
In English this term, we are reading the text 'Cosmic', this text is very engaging and funny, so we hope that the children will enjoy it. Throughout the term the children will be learning some new styles of writing such as; persuasive writing, diary entries, predictions and

play scripts.

In our Maths lessons, we are focusing on Geometry and Measure. The children will be exploring shape with a focus on angles, lengths and translation. We will finish the year with converting units of measure before we recap a few previous topics, so we are Year 6 ready!



Our creative topic this term is 'Levers and Pulleys'. Throughout our creative lessons, we will be exploring levers and pulleys that are used in our lives and will design, create and evaluate our own 'moving hand' lever and pulley toy.



In RE, the children will be exploring 'The Kingdom of God'. Throughout this topic, the children will be able to make clear connections between the belief of The Kingdom of God and how Christians put their beliefs into practice in different ways.

In Art this term, we will be exploring Picasso's work and will create our own Picasso inspired portraits.

In French, the children will be learning vocabulary around journeys and directions. At the end of the term, the children will be able to use their new French vocabulary to create a travel brochure to advertise holidays in French.



In PSHE, the children will be exploring change and will answer the question 'Is change always good?' during their final

PSHE assembly of the year. They will be exploring changes in their lives and in their world, and we will discuss strategies to cope with potentially uncomfortable changes.
